

Illinois WEGrow Summary

The data is in on four Illinois WEGrow locations, and they are a reflection of the varying weather patterns we had around the state, yield averages ranged from 187-260 BPA! I broke the data out into early and late maturity sets with 112/113 as the cutoff. My starting employment with **INTEGRA** on September 20 barely gave me any time to take plot notes as some trials were already harvested by then!

Some key learnings, we have a solid line up with different sets of hybrids taking the top positions at each location. INTEGRA 5770, and 6588 were the prettiest with excellent staygreen and intactness. INTEGRA 5802, 5939, and 5770 consistently placed in the top half of the early trials and 6555, 6410, 6533, and 6432 took turns leading the late test.

Keep an eye out for more data from surrounding states as it comes in. I walked some very consistent trials in Wisconsin and Michigan, and all types in Iowa.
